We're proud that we are well ahead in baptisms, Confirmations, and weddings and virtually even in First Communion. The Sunday Mass attendance and offertory numbers have steadily risen since 2020. We think it's likely we'll return to the 2019 numbers this year.

We recognize our upper-middle-income town has helped our offertory numbers and our traditional church building attracts wedding couples and others from surrounding towns. The greatest contributor to our success, however, is the loyalty of our parishioners and the dedication of our staff and liturgical ministers.

Only one number, religious education enrollment, is down more than 5%. Our religious ed program is flexible, offering school year, intensive summer, and home school options. We are now tracking the program's effectiveness through test scores and we will remain open to parent input in order to offer the the best education to the broadest number of students.
